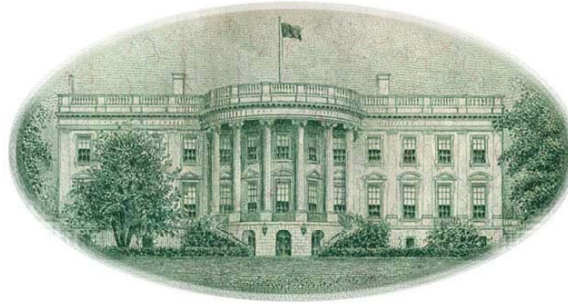

The 2008 Primary election campaign provides an ideal opportunity for students to learn about the American political process first-hand. The most up-to-date information is contained in daily headlines, stories, editorial cartoons and commentary. Below is a compilation of important dates for newspaper coverage during the primary election and President Bush's final State of the Union address. Teachers may order the entire package or may choose selected dates to meet special interests. Supplemental instructional materials appropriate for high school government, civics, political science, contemporary history and social studies classrooms will be forwarded to teachers using **The Patriot-News** in their classrooms.

The package price for 17 daily newspapers and two Sunday editions is \$3.00 per student. If you do not wish to order all dates in the package, you may order newspapers on specific dates. Scholastic subscription rate for **The Patriot-News** is .125 cents per newspaper; scholastic subscription rate for **Sunday Patriot-News** is .4375 cents per newspaper. A minimum order of 5 newspapers **per day** is required to qualify for the reduced scholastic subscription rate. Due to the nature of political coverage, these newspapers are not sponsored, nor are they available for vacation donation funding.

To place your order, complete the order form below and return via e-mail or fax to 717-255-4101. Indicate quantity of papers you wish to receive each day. Daily newspapers are delivered on day of publication. Sunday newspapers are delivered in part on Friday, Saturday and Monday.
